Each Title 1 School shall jointly develop with parents and family members of participating children, a written plan that shall describe how the school will carry out the requirements. Parents shall be notified of the plan in an understandable and uniform format and, to the extent practical, provided in a language the parents can understand. The school plan must be made available to the local community and updated and agreed on by parents periodically to meet the changing needs of parents and the school.

Together we will provide a safe environment where we empower ALL students to be independent thinkers, prideful citizens, and develop a life-long love for learning. When we say together, this includes our community and families. We believe our parent and families are necessary for our students' success. Our vision is that all students will learn at high levels to be successful in college, career or life.

What is required: Assurances we will involve an adequate representation of parents, or establish a parent advisory board to:

- represent families, in developing and evaluating the "school parent and family engagement plan" that describes how the school will carry out its required family engagement activities.
- Hold an annual meeting for families to explain the Title 1 Program and the rights of parents to be involved. Offer other meetings/workshops at flexible times.
- Use a portion of Title 1 funds to support parent and family engagement and involve parents in deciding how these funds are to be used. Involve parents in the planning, review and improvement of the title 1 program.
- Develop a school-parent compact that outlines how parents, students and school staff will share the responsibility for improving student achievement and describes how parents and teachers will communicate.
- offer assistance to parents in understanding the education system, and state standards, and how to support their children's achievement. Provide materials and training to help parents support their child's learning at home. Educate teachers and other school staff, including school leaders, on how to engage families effectively. Coordinate with other federal and state programs, including preschool programs.
- Provide information in a format and language parents can understand, and offer information in other languages as feasible.
